Baia Mare

Baia Mare is a welcoming city located in the historical region of Maramureș, in the north of Romania. Known for its rich cultural heritage, green surroundings, and relaxed lifestyle, the city offers a perfect balance between academic life and leisure.

With a long history dating back to medieval times, Baia Mare has developed into a vibrant student city, ideal for international experiences.



Baia Mare is a historic city in northern Romania, known for its **rich deposits of gold and silver**, which shaped its development from the Middle Ages. First officially mentioned in 1329 as Rivulus Dominarum ("Ladies' River"), the city quickly became an important mining and trading center in the Maramureș region. Over time, it was also known as Frauenbach (German) and Nagybánya (Hungarian), reflecting its **multicultural past** and the influence of various communities who contributed to its growth.

In the late 19th and early 20th centuries, Baia Mare gained international recognition as an artistic hub through the famous **Baia Mare School of Painting**, attracting artists from across Europe. After Transylvania became part of Romania in 1918, the city continued to develop while preserving its cultural heritage. Today, Baia Mare offers a unique mix of history, art, and a relaxed lifestyle, making it a welcoming place for students from around the world.

Tourist attractions

Stephen's Tower (Turnul Ștefan) is the city's most iconic landmark, located in the Old Town. Dating back to the 15th century, it offers a great panoramic view over the city. Nearby, you can visit the **Old Town Square** (Piața Libertății), a charming area filled with historic buildings, cafés, and a lively atmosphere. Another important site is the **Mineralogy Museum**, which showcases the region's rich mining heritage and impressive mineral collections.

For nature lovers, Baia Mare is surrounded by stunning landscapes. You can explore **Mogoșa Lake** or **Șuior Resort**, both located in the nearby mountains, ideal for hiking, relaxing, or winter sports. The **Village Museum** (Muzeul Satului) is also worth visiting, offering insight into traditional Maramureș life with authentic wooden houses and cultural exhibits.

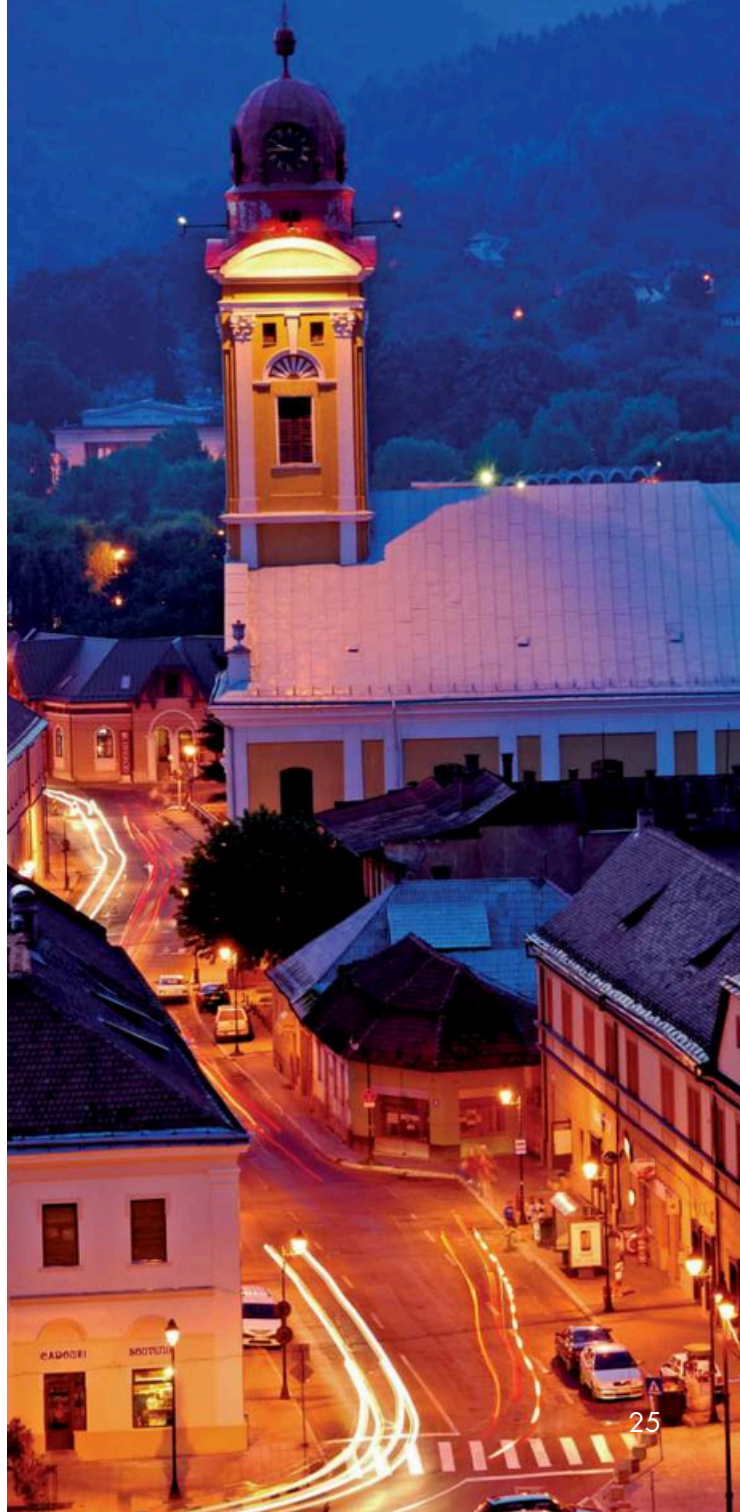
